## HANDOUT 1: Importance of Innovation – Role Play

## **Role Play**

The company Tecidos Mota is located in the business district of the city of Porto, Portugal. They have been manufacturing quality fabrics for more than 20 years and are the main suppliers to the country's garment factories. With the Covid-19 pandemic, many customers ended up closing their doors and the company Tecidos Mota is in a decision phase between:

- or use creativity and make the problem an innovative solution.

Imagine that each of you is at the partners' meeting where that decision will have to be made.

The President will ask you to come up with creative ideas, to bet on innovation and to save the company. As there are negative people everywhere, the teacher will play the role of the person who hinders the arguments of others. The idea is to check if the creativity and innovation of your ideas are good enough for the teacher to be without arguments.

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
